TRANSFER AGREEMENT



- The University of Bridgeport assures the acceptance of an Associate Degree graduate who has earned a grade point average of 2.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale) into their Baccalaureate Degree program; 2.5 for Accounting, Biology, Business Administration, Computer Applications and Information Systems, Marketing, Management, Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Math and Dental Hygiene. Students who are accepted with 60 transfer credits will be classified as Juniors.
- Transfer students will receive academic credit for all college-level courses applied toward the requirements of the Associate Degree, excluding D grades. A maximum of sixty-six (66) credits will be accepted for transfer.
- Non-credit or remedial courses judged to be below college level may not be accepted for transfer.
- 4. It is understood that if a student does not have the foundation or skill to enroll in an upper level course because he/she has not taken introductory courses, he/she will be required to take any necessary prerequisite(s). Therefore the University of Bridgeport cannot assure that every student will complete the requirements for the Baccalaureate Degree in four semesters.
- The University of Bridgeport catalog contains all information about degree requirements. Students wishing to plan their Associate Degree programs to ensure meeting prerequisites for upper division courses are encouraged to communicate early with the Transfer Counselor at the University of Bridgeport to secure specific information about transfer credits.
- 6 This agreement will be reviewed bi-annually and may be revised at anytime by mutual consent.
- 7. The agreement is expected to continue in force indefinitely but may be terminated by either party with not less than one year's notice.
- 8. Attached are copies of detailed transfer agreements for various programs.
- 9. When all necessary college and professional approvals have been secured for this program, a joint announcement of the program will be made by the colleges.

 - E. Integrated Studies: 3 Credits, Mass Communications
- 3. Capstone Seminar: (3 Credits) (Open only to Seniors)
