Articulation Agreement

For A Transfer Program Between

School of Nursing
Miami-Dade Community College

and

Division of Nursing School of Health California State University, Dominguez Hills

The purpose of this agreement is to enhance the transfer process of graduates of the Associate in Science (AS) in Nursing from Miami-Dade Community College (M-DCC) to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) at California State University Dominguez Hills (CSUDH). This agreement shall establish the conditions under which students from M-DCC shall progress to upper division status as a Nursing major at CSUDH. In addition, the agreement shall include the formation of mechanisms for the ongoing monitoring and review of articulation progress and adherence to the conditions.

1 Program of Study

- 1.1 Participating students shall complete at M-DCC:
 - An AS degree in Nursing.
 - 30 transferable general education credits.
- 1.2 All the courses specified in the Appendix are transferable to CSUDH. Therefore, participating students will be able to complete a program of study at CSUDH in a time that equals approximately the number of hours required in the junior and senior years of the degree program being sought.

2. Admission and Readmission

- 2.1 M-DCC is an open-admissions institution that assesses the holders of a high school diploma (or equivalent) wishing to enter this program and places them into courses on the basis of their academic background and/or demonstrated experience in specific courses. Applicants may be required to participate in the M-DCC assessment program.
- A student completing the program of study in 1.1 will be guaranteed admission with upper division standing to the Nursing major at CSUDH if the conditions of admission under "3.4: Conditions of admission: AS students" are met.

3. Conditions of Admission

3.1 So as to assure the admission and academic success of participating students, M-DCC and CSUDH agree to develop, maintain, and improve continuously a program management and reporting system.

3.2 CSUDH University will:

- Accept M-DCC's model of 60 credits for transfer, including general education and nursing courses.
- Establish a tracking system in Nursing for M-DCC AS students.

3.3 CSUDH's Nursing program for AS students will consist of 120 credits in total (see Appendix A):

- Including 30 credits for nursing courses taken at the community college.
- Including 30 credits of general education taken at the community college.
- Including completion of 48 credits of required nursing courses at CSUDH.
- Including completion of 12 additional credits of general education requirements taken at the upper division (CSUDH).
- Excluding foreign language deficiencies (8-10 credits).

3.4 Conditions of admission: AS students

- Have a minimum of 56 semester units of transferable college credit with a grade point average of 2.0 (C) or better in all transferable course work.
- Have completed 30 credits of general education course work that meet the CSU requirements.
- Hold current and active RN licensure in the United States.

4. Nursing Curriculum Change and Accreditation Status

4. M-DCC School of Nursing will:

- Notify CSUDH Division of Nursing of any nursing curriculum change.
- Notify CSUDH Division of Nursing of any change in accreditation status.

4.2 CSUDH Division of Nursing will:


- Notify M-DCC School of Nursing of any nursing curriculum change.
- Notify M-DCC School of Nursing of any change in accreditation status.

5. Termination/Modification

- 5.1 This Articulation Agreement is subject to change or modification by mutual written consent between the parties hereto.
- This Articulation Agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice to the other party given at least one year in advance of such termination date. However, it is understood and agreed that any student participating in the AS in Nursing at M-DCC specifically tracked for admission to CSUDH or already admitted to CSUDH due to this agreement will be allowed to complete the program notwithstanding the termination provisions above, so long as the student remains in good academic standing and is making measured progress towards completion of a degree program.

5.2 This Articulation Agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice to the other party given at least one year in advance of such termination date. However, it is understood and agreed that any student participating in the AS in Nursing at M-DCC specifically tracked for admission to CSUDH or already admitted to CSUDH due to this agreement will be allowed to complete the program notwithstanding the termination provisions above, so long as the student remains in good academic standing and is making measured progress towards completion of a degree program.
