

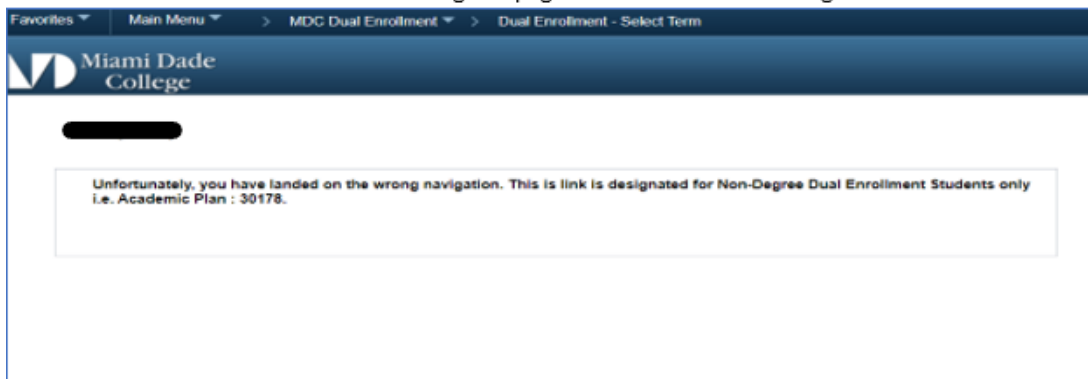
INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEARCHING AND SELECTING COURSES USING THE DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENT PORTAL

STEP 1: USE the following link to log into your MDC Account:

Credit Application

Dual Enrollment

Dual Enrollment Credit & Grading Policies

- By participating in this program, students will be starting their college academic record. All grades earned will be part of their official MDC transcripts, including failing grades and withdrawals. Grades, including withdrawal grades, may affect high school graduation, subsequent postsecondary admission, and financial aid eligibility at MDC or another college/university. Students who fail or withdraw from a course cannot repeat the same course as a Dual Enrollment student, but can enroll in other courses, if eligible.
- Students must meet statutory eligibility requirements to participate in the dual enrollment program as **set forth in Section 1007.271, Florida Statutes**. Students must maintain a 2.0 MDC GPA as well as a 3.0 unweighted high school GPA to continue eligibility in the program.
- College credit earned at MDC will transfer to any Florida public college or university offering that course with the same prefix and number.
- Upon high school graduation, if students do not attend the same college or university where they earned the Dual Enrollment credit, the application of transfer credit may vary at the receiving institution.

The search function will let you know whether a class is open or closed. It will provide meeting dates and times. Click on the section to see the instruction modality (in-person, blended, Online, or MDC LIVE).

****IMPORTANT:**

1. Don't Forget to Save the Courses to your shopping cart.
2. Remember to validate your class choices, as this will help determine whether you are eligible to take the courses that you have selected. The system will screen for any pre-requisite or co-requisite courses as well as other determining factors.
3. You will see all classes that have been approved by your secondary school counselor. All approved classes will be locked. You will be not be able to change a course once it is approved.
4. A green check indicates that you have been enrolled in a class. A red X means that you have not been enrolled.
5. When selecting *My Class Alternatives*, you can select different sections of the same course as well as different courses. If one of your class choices is closed by the time your enrollment request reaches MDC, the Dual Enrollment Coordinator will choose the alternate course that you rank #1. Please rank your alternate courses in terms of preference.
