Rolling Admissions Procedures

Rolling Admissions window opens June 1st . [Apply Now](#).

Three rounds of selection:

- First round apply June 1st until July 15th, it will be selected by July 30th. Selected students will be notified by mid-August.
- Second round apply August 1st until September 15th, it will be selected by September 30th. Selected Students will be notified by mid-October.
- Final round apply September 1st will be selected after the application deadline of October 15th. Selected students will be notified by mid-December

Eligibility

To be eligible for rolling admissions students must:

- Ensure completion of [Step 2](#) on the application and admissions page, including submission of the [PA Program specific application](#) through the [PA Candidate Documents Upload Portal](#)
- Successfully completed all requirements for admissions to the PA program (Including HSC003/L courses or waiver).
- Submit transcripts for evaluation. For more information about submitting transcripts to the College [visit the MDC Transcripts website](#).
- Take the PA-CAT. Please note it takes 4 weeks for the PA-CAT scores to be sent to MDC. To register [visit the PA-CAT website](#).
 - *Please note the program must receive PA-CAT scores before you are considered for early admissions.*

Additional Information

Candidates are encouraged to apply as early as possible. Candidates not selected in one round will still be considered for remaining rounds.

Candidates selected for early consideration will be invited for the admissions essay test and interview.

Candidates who are selected early (prior to October 15th) and accept a seat in the class must sign an agreement committing to the MDC PA program and willingly agree to not accept admissions into another PA program.
