THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE UNANIMOUSLY AGREED TO INVITE THE SIX (6) SHORTLISTED PROPOSERS TO PRESENTATIONS AND Q&A SESSIONS AT A LATER DATE. THE SIX PROPOSERS SHORTLISTED INCLUDED:

ON JULY 25, 2019, THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE CONVENED AND ALL 6 SHORTLISTED PROPOSERS PROVIDED PRESENTATIONS AND DEMONSTRATIONS OF THEIR PRODUCTS. ON AUGUST 9, 2019, THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE CONVENED IN A PUBLIC EVALUATION COMMITTEE MEETING AND UNANIMOUSLY AGREED TO PREQUALIFY ALL 6 SHORTLISTED PROPOSERS. ALL 6 COMPANIES WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE COLLEGE PRESIDENT AND TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR PREQUALIFICATION APPROVAL AT THE SEPTEMBER 17, 2019 SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING
